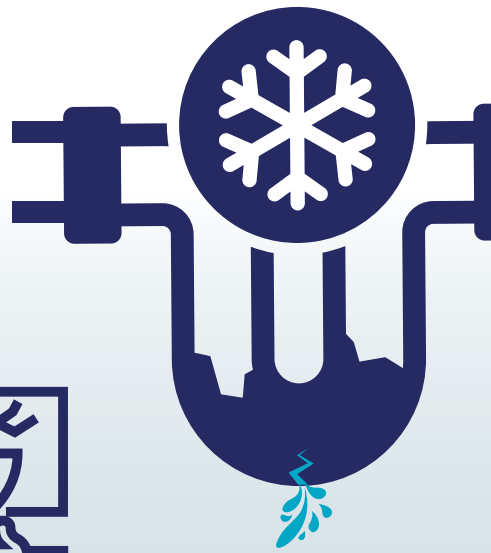
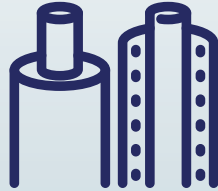


HOW TO PREVENT FROZEN PIPES



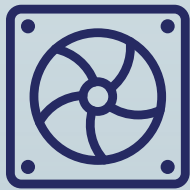
Keep your house at least 65 °F



Insulate all pipes



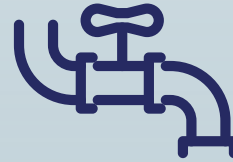
Seal all cracks, holes and other openings



Use a fan to circulate warm air around pipes



Let faucets drip to prevent freezing



Shut off the water supply when your home is unoccupied

If you do end up with a frozen pipe:



Cut off the flow of water at the main shutoff



Use a hair dryer or heating pad to thaw pipes



Turn on the faucet so water begins to flow as ice melts



Properly mop and dry any spills to help prevent mold
